Open Art Exhibition

This exhibition is open to amateur artists of all ages, residing within the SO41, SO42 and BH25 postcodes. We are keen to showcase the wide range of local talent within our region.

ENTRIES:

The theme is 'Solstice'. Work must be linked to this theme.

Each artist may submit one item.

We can accept two-dimensional painting, drawing, printmaking or mixed media.

The maximum size for any work is 64cm (25 inches) in any direction, including frame.

Entry forms and payment to be sent to the Lymington Community Centre to arrive no later than Tuesday 1st June 2010.

Please enclose a SAE for confirmation, exhibit number and receipt

The Festival Committee will endeavour to hang all entries, their decision is final

FEES:

A non refundable fee of £5 per entry is charged for each work submitted and must be paid at the time of submission (Cheques made payable to L.C.A.)

SALES:

Work may be available for sale. The Lymington Arts Festival will take a commission of 20% on the sale price of the work.

The Festival will make payments for sold works at the end of the calendar month, following the end of the exhibition. Artists should receive payment by 31st July 2010.

SUBMISSIONS:

Work to be delivered to the Lymington Community Centre from Monday 7 June to Saturday 12 June between 10am and 4pm and 10am to 12 noon on Saturday. No work will be accepted outside of these times. All work to be delivered ready to hang.

Work must be suitably wrapped and protected and clearly labelled on the reverse with Title, Exhibit Number, Medium and Artist's name and address.

Lymington Arts Festival, Lymington Community Centre, their committee and officers take no responsibility for any work lost or damaged during transportation, storage or exhibition. Artists should take out their own insurance to cover their work.

COLLECTION:

No exhibit can be removed before the close of the exhibition.

Work can be collected from the Lymington Community Centre from Monday 21 June to Saturday 26 June, between 10am and 4pm, 10am to 12 noon on Saturday.
